2020 Back-to-Learning (B2L) campaign

Terms of Reference

Young Community Mobilizers (Volunteers):

- Are the change drivers of the project. They should be selected carefully.
- Responsible for door-to-door registration of out-of-school children/adolescent girls.
- Engage in awareness raising and peer-to-peer dialogue through communicating the importance of education and learning continuity with community members including parents and children.
- Upload reliable data to the Back-to-Learning (B2L) online Information Management System through smartphones/tablets.
- Each community mobilizer is expected to support enrollment of 2 out-of-school children per a working day.

Team Leader or Supervisor:

- Leads the B2L campaign through community mobilizers at district level.
- Manage the field teams through mapping the target blocks, identify the target households and provide continuous guidance to community mobilizers.
- Each field team consists of two young community mobilizers, preferably a female and a male.
- Monitor the ongoing works virtually and physically.
- Verify the entered data by field teams/ young community mobilizers.

Caseworker:

- Support the community mobilizers to address the cases that might have social roots.
- Address the cases that may not be resolved by the community mobilizer. For example:
 - > an out-of-school child would like to go back to learning but the family is objecting
 - > the family supports the child to go back for learning, but the child is objecting.
- refer special cases to relevant departments for advice or direct support. For example: an abused child by family, community or school, drop out of girls due to child marriage, etc.
- Any case, that does not follow instructions of MoE, should not be addressed by the caseworker.
- Manage 5% of the target cases which includes both back to learning and referral cases.

Information Manager:

- Manage the Back-to-Learning (B2L) data and information collected by the community mobilizers.
- Guide community mobilizers on how to collect and upload data into the Back-to-Learning (B2L)

- online Information Management System.
- Verify and certify the uploaded data by young community mobilizers.
- Generate reports for the project manager.

Project Coordinator: (One per governorate)

- 1. Prepare data on out-of-school children and adolescent from Directorates of Education (DoE)s in the target districts.
- 2. In coordination with team leader, identify the most disadvantaged areas and groups in the target districts.
- 3. Provide the required information for enrollment.
- 4. In coordination with the supervisor/team leader, monitor the ongoing works virtually and physically.
- 5. In coordination with supervisor/team leader, verify the entered data by field teams/ young community mobilizers

Project Manager:

- 1. In coordination with GDoE focal point, leads and manage the B2L campaign at governorate level.
- 2. Ensure proper action plans are in place to guide the field teams.
- 3. Monitor the ongoing works virtually and physically on regular basis.
- 4. Ensure reliable information uploaded into the Back-to-Learning (B2L) online Information Management System.
- 5. Accountable to achieve the planned results (i.e. meet the planned target).
